


Melcome

Shorter travel time, increased bus and CTrain frequency and extended service hours are some of the benefits transit customers can look forward to with the opening of the northwest CTrain extension. The Dalhousie Station opens to transit service December 15 becoming Calgary's 23rd suburban CTrain Station.

The last LRT extension was completed in 2001 with the opening of the Canyon Meadows and Fish Creek Lacombe Stations. This was the first expansion in over 10 years and was the beginning of a program that will see each CTrain line extended over the next five years.

In June 2004, the South CTrain line will be extended to Shawnessy and Somerset/Bridlewood. An extension of the northeast line to McKnight-Westwinds Station is scheduled for 2010.





Purpose Of the Rider's Guide

The Rider's Guide to the NW CTrain Extension and Feeder Bus Network will assist you in planning your transit trip when the new Dalhousie Station opens December 15, 2003.

This Rider's Guide will provide you with information about the new station and a preview to the new and revised bus routes and levels of service. Pocket Schedules (containing detailed schedule and stop information) will be available at the Calgary Transit Customer Service Centre at 224 – 7 Avenue S.W., most transit fare vendors and www.calgarytransit.com in December.

The feeder bus network for the Dalhousie Station was developed through a collaborative joint planning process, which included stakeholders from community associations, transit customers, area businesses,

Calgary Transit Staff and area Aldermen. The process included stakeholder meetings, community meetings and several open houses. City Council approved the feeder bus network in October 2003.

The feeder network illustrated in this guide, includes the reallocation of resources from existing premium express services in Silver Springs, Ranchlands, The Hamptons and Hawkwood into an improved feeder bus network. The reallocation of premium express bus service is based on City Council approved guidelines. The final day for operation of Premium Express Routes 60, 61, 68, 74 and 127 will be December 12, 2003.

The new feeder bus network incorporates a phased approach to introducing feeder bus service to the Dalhousie Station, to allow for a review of traffic in the Dalhousie Station area. For the first six-months of operation, feeder routes serving communities west of Nose Hill Dr. will continue to travel to Brentwood Station (i.e. Routes 98, 199, 299, 421 and 426). As well, the communities of Arbour Lake and Scenic Acres will retain their premium express service. The results of this review will be discussed with the NW stakeholder group and will be presented to City Council for direction regarding future changes to feeder bus and premium express services.

The communities of Citadel, Rocky Ridge, Royal Oak and Tuscany will retain their premium express service until the CTrain is extended to Crowfoot.

Introduction to the Dalhousie Station

The Dalhousie Station is located east of 53 St and north of Crowchild Trail. In conjunction with the station opening, new and revised bus routes affecting the communities of Brentwood, Varsity Acres, Varsity Estates, Silver Springs, Scenic Acres, Hawkwood, Ranchlands, Dalhousie, Hamptons and Edgemont are in effect.

The design of the new station and Park and Ride was a collaborative effort involving community stakeholders and the Transportation Project Office, which undertakes projects on behalf of The City of Calgary. The features of Dalhousie Station include:

- Park and Ride for approximately 730 vehicles, located north
 of the station with access from Dalhousie Dr. Short term parking
 stalls (up to 4 hr. maximum), accessible parking and "Kiss and
 Ride" drop-off zones.
- Lockers and racks for bicycles.
- Access to the station using pedestrian bridge from bus loop.
- Stairways, elevators and escalators inside the station.
- Security and safety features, suitable fencing and appropriate landscaping.









Map of Bus Routes to Dalhousie Station



Calgary Transit Web-Site

www.calgarytransit.com can provide information on customer services, fares, individual route maps, schedules and accessible transportation.

Teleride

Teleride is an interactive telephone system that provides the most current schedule information for your bus stop. Call 974-4000 and enter your four-digit stop number, located at the bottom of the sign at your bus zone, to obtain current and future bus schedule times or general transit information.

Transit Maps and Schedules

The Transit system map shows all of Calgary Transit's bus and CTrain routes. These maps are available at the Calgary Transit Customer Service Centre (224 – 7th. Ave. S.W.), the plaza level of the downtown municipal building and some vendors.

The pocket schedules for each individual route list the times when the bus leaves your starting point and when you will reach your destination, as well as, bus stop locations, a route map, the four digit Teleride numbers and other helpful information. Schedules are available from the Calgary Transit Customer Service Centre, your bus operator or call 262-1000 or TTY 268-8087 (for hard of hearing).

Customer Service

The Customer Service Centre (224 – 7 Avenue S.W.) is open weekdays from 10:00am to 5:30pm. You can purchase passes or tickets, obtain printed transit maps, route schedules and other brochures, or receive help planning your transit trip. Customers requiring information about Access Calgary may do so at the Customer Service Centre or call 537-7770. The Lost Property office is also located here (telephone 268-1600).

Customer service representatives may be reached at 262-1000 (6:00am to 9:00pm weekdays and 8am to 6:00pm on weekends and holidays). Customer service representatives can assist you in finding the bus or CTrain route you need, tell you where your bus zone or stop is located and where to transfer to connecting transit services.

Safety & Security Measures

Uniformed and plain-clothes Protective Services Officers patrol Calgary Transit facilities around-the-clock. They protect transit customers, employees and property; promote public safety and awareness; and enforce by-laws and provincial statutes.

A network of over 200 closed circuit cameras exist throughout the CTrain line which monitor the stations, platforms, escalators, halls and stairs. These cameras are overseen around-the-clock by Calgary Transit personnel. Other security features include the Transit Help Intercom (HELP) System, available on all CTrains, platforms and stations. All CTrain cars, platforms and stations are equipped with a red HELP button or handset so in an emergency, customers can contact Calgary Transit Control Centre personnel who will provide instructions and send emergency help immediately. Calgary Transit bus operators also have radio-equipment they can use in an emergency to notify the appropriate personnel.
