69 STREET PARK AND RIDE/BUS TERMINAL CLOSURE

Introduction

• 69 Street Park and Ride/Bus Terminal closed effective Satuday, June 5, 2010.

In order to accommodate the construction of the new 69 ST LRT Station and park and ride/bus terminal, the existing park and ride/bus terminal will be closed starting Saturday, June 5, 2010.

New Bus Terminal at Sirocco Drive

All bus routes now serving the 69 Street terminal will be re-routed to the new temporary bus terminal at Sirocco Drive and Signature Park S.W. (see map on Page 7).

Sirocco Park and Ride

Sirocco Park and Ride has been expanded to replace the parking stalls removed from the 69 Street park and ride lot. Total of 446(186 new) park and ride stalls will be available here.

Westside Recreation Centre

For travel to the Westside Recreation Centre, stops will be established on 17 Avenue and on 69 Street depending on construction activities.

Changes are effective until West LRT opens in December 2012
 Calgary Transit has made every effort to ensure that customers will be able to make the connections that they need with minimum disruption.








Sirocco Bus Terminal




Route 2 - Mt. Pleasant/Killarney/17 Av






Route 53 - Signal Hill




Route 67 - Signal Hill Express




Route 301 - BRT North/West







Route 401 - Glenbrook



Route 438 - Discovery Ridge




Route 439 - Westside Recreation Centre






Route 456 - Aspen Woods

West LRT Alignment Completion: Dec. 2012



Transit information sources

Alittle advance planning can make your transit trip more comfortable and convenient. The following are some of our information sources.

Calgary Transit website

At **calgarytransit.com**, we provide trip planning, information about schedules, individual route maps, fares, accessible transportation, customer service and upcoming events.

Trip Planning on the web

Plan your next trip by bus or CTrain online. Simply enter where you are leaving from and where you wish to go and the time you would like to travel. Calgary Transit Trip Planning will provide you with a complete itinerary of your trip, including where to catch your bus or train, transfer connections, and a complete schedule for departure and arrival.

To plan your trip using Trip Planning on the web, go to **calgarytransit.com**

Trip planning with Google Transit

Calgary Transit on Google is available on mobile devices (such as iPhone, Blackberry and Windows Mobile) putting trip planning right in the palm of your hand. Google Maps supports multiple languages, so it's easy for international users.

To plan your trip using Google Transit, go to calgarytransit.com/html/google.html

Teleride

Teleride is an interactive telephone system that provides the most current schedule information for your bus stop. Call 403-974-4000 and enter your four-digit stop number, (located at the bottom of the sign at your bus stop or found on the website) to obtain current and future schedule times or general transit information.

Pocket schedules

A pocket schedule for each individual route shows a route's frequency and travel time. The schedules also list bus stop locations, a route map, the four-digit Teleride numbers and other helpful information. Schedules are available from the Calgary Transit Customer Service Centre, your bus operator or by calling 403-262-1000 or TTY 403-268-8087 (for the hearing impaired).

Transit fares

Transit fares are the same for the bus and the CTrain. There are a number of ways to pay for your trip.

Fare options (2010)
