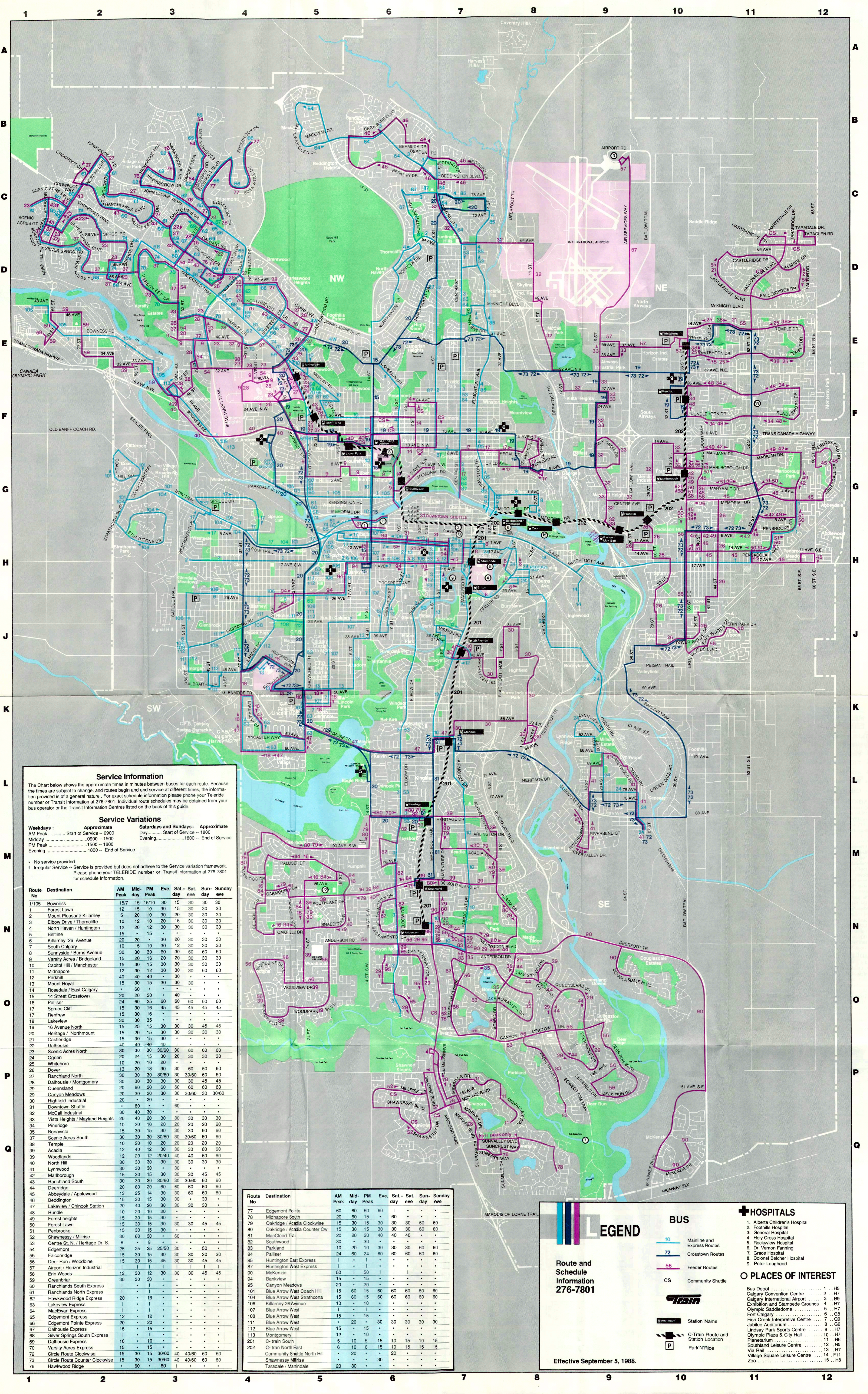




Service Information

CALGARY TRANSIT

It's easy! Follow these three steps and you're on your way!

- Which route do I use?**
To find the bus or C-Train route that takes you to your destination, check the map on the other side or phone Transit Information, 276-7801.
- When does the bus arrive?**
Call Teleride to find out when the next two or three buses will arrive at your stop. Find out more about Teleride in the section below or use a route schedule to find out when the bus leaves your neighbourhood and when you'll reach your destination. Get a route schedule at any of the CT Information Centres listed below or phone 276-7801 and we'll mail one to you.
- How much does it cost?**

PASSES

Monthly Pass
ADULT \$38.00 CHILD (6-14 years) \$30.00

Purchase your pass at the beginning of the month and enjoy unlimited rides for that month on regular bus and C-Train service.

Passes may be loaned to family and friends, but may be used only by one person at a time.

Show your pass to the operator when boarding a bus.

Carry your pass as proof of payment when on the C-Train and in Fare Restricted Areas.

Day Pass
ADULT \$ 3.50 CHILD (6-14 years) \$ 2.00

If you're expecting visitors, the best way for them to enjoy Calgary is with a Day Pass-it provides unlimited rides after 0900 on weekdays and all day Saturday, Sunday or holidays. The Day Pass is easy to use:

- Scratch off the grey material covering the day and month you wish to ride.
- Prior to boarding the C-Train, validate your pass at a ticket vending machine. Show your pass to the driver when boarding a bus.

TICKETS

There are three convenient types of tickets, select the one that's best for you!

- Tickets can be used at any time, there's no expiry date.
- When boarding the bus, tear a ticket out of the book and drop it into the farebox. If you must change routes to continue your journey, ask your driver for a transfer when boarding.
- When using the C-Train be sure to validate your ticket at a ticket vending machine before entering the Fare Restricted Area. When transferring from the C-Train to a bus, present your ticket to the driver. Please do not put validated tickets into the farebox.

CASH

If you're riding the bus, EXACT CASH should be deposited into the farebox when boarding.

PLEASE USE COINS! Using coins instead of paper currency will help Calgary Transit lower the costs associated with emptying jammed fareboxes and processing crumpled dollar bills.

If you must change routes during your journey, ask your driver for a TRANSFER when you board the bus. The transfer allows you to board the first connecting bus or C-Train within 90 minutes of the time you received the transfer. If you have to make several transfers, ask the driver to check the transfer to ensure that it will remain valid for your entire journey.

When using the C-Train be sure to purchase a ticket receipt from a ticket vending machine before entering the Fare Restricted Area. Exact coins are required for these machines, they do not provide change.

Please remember that change for the ticket machines is not available at all stations. Be sure to bring exact change with you.

HOW TO USE
TELERIDE

Teleride gives you reliable scheduled arrival times for the next Calgary Transit buses due at your stop. It's easy to use, here's how:

- Go to the bus stop that you use and find the Teleride number on the sign or, phone 276-7801 and ask the operator for your Teleride number.
- Write down the Teleride number for the stops you use most. Keep the Teleride numbers near your telephone at home and at work.
- Before you leave, call your Teleride number. A friendly computer voice tells you when the next two or three buses will arrive at that stop.

Use it every day . . .

- The message for your stop is updated constantly and will provide details on delays that may occur and upcoming service changes.

C-Train

- There is a Teleride number for each C-Train route:
- Route 201 Anderson/University 260-5201
- Route 202 Whitehorn 260-5202

When you call, the message will tell you how frequently the C-Train operates rather than when the next train arrives.

FACTS ABOUT
BUS ZONES

Bus routes generally operate along collector standard roadways in residential areas.

- On-street parking and stopping are prohibited within a bus zone.
- Bus zones are usually located immediately beyond intersections (on the far side) to ensure safety for both pedestrians and vehicles.
- The bus zone may include a sign, concrete apron, bus bench or bus shelter located on the City-owned property adjacent to your home.
- Prospective home buyers should be aware that bus zone locations in new subdivisions are established prior to residential construction. In most cases, the zone will have a concrete apron and/or lengths of vertical curbing.

C-TRAIN SAFETY

- Hold on while standing so that you will be able to brace yourself if the C-Train has to come to a sudden stop.
- Stand away from doors to allow passengers to enter and exit the C-Train.
- Stand back of platform edge when waiting for the C-Train.
- Cross the tracks only at designated pedestrian crossings. Stop, look both ways and listen before proceeding across.

USING
THE C-TRAIN

The C-Train is FREE along the 7th Avenue Transit Mall, between 10 Street West and 4 Street East. A fare must be paid to travel beyond 7th Avenue.

Identify your train by watching the digital information signs located at all 7th Avenue C-Train platforms for a message that identifies the approaching train.

PROOF OF PAYMENT
The C-Train uses the proof of payment system, so it's up to you to make sure you've paid your fare prior to entering Fare Restricted Areas.

- validated day pass
- C-Train ticket receipt
- Senior Citizen pass

Smoking is prohibited on Calgary Transit vehicles, bus shelters and in all C-Train stations. No smoking signs are posted in accordance with Bylaw 15M85.

As a courtesy to your fellow passengers and to assist in minimizing maintenance costs, please do not put your feet on the seats.
